Why was insurance not purchased for the loaned out chrome books? I have to pay \$250 for a damaged chrome book which was an accident by an eight year old it wasn't malicious in intent! There are students as young as 4 years old using these chrome books Accidents will happen. We are in an urban low-income community charging parents these replacement costs is a detriment to those already struggling families!

Many studies have shown throughout the years that too much screen time affects children impaired vision, headaches, including stress these studies were from prior years including recent from the National Institute of Health study says children shouldn't have more than 2.25 hours of screen time increasing those hours could cause "thinning of the brain cortex". That being said student are spending too much screen time with google classroom reducing the amount of screen time could relieve students from stress and anxiety. I personally had to get my kids glasses for the time spent on the computer something they don't need since they have 20/20 vision. If we can find a way to supplement the time with other work like pamphlets would help the student I have a child in kindergarten and 8th grade. It's hard on both I wouldn't send my child back to school during a pandemic but I do hope the board can look into the student spending too much time on the computer.

Hi, My Name is Kalpesh Rana. I am a resident of Passaic since the last 42 years. I am try to register my son into PreK (Aarav Rana). I filled out application and went for interview, only to be denied. My son's DOB is 11/5/17, which is 5 days after the cut off period. I am requesting for the Board to relax this policy, so that my son has a chance to get a sound education, at such a developing stage in his life. I feel that just for a 5 day lapse, its such a shame to stop his developmental skills. Especially since he was enrolled in a Learning Center since he was 2 years old. Please help me to get him registered for this calendar year as soon as possible, since we still have 2 more marking periods left. Due to covid 19, we have been through a great degree of difficulty. I wish that this process and the desire to place him on track to an education, wasn't an addition to that difficulty, as it has become! Your help and understanding is greatly requested at this time.

Mr. Muñoz provided a response regarding insurance for computers and explained the Board Policy.

Mr. Truppo provided a response to the issue of screen time. A committee was working to add and produce actionable strategies on instructional strategies, to minimize screen time.

Mr. Truppo will follow up with a memo and provide a whole list some of the strategies that the committee has recommended for screen time.

Regarding registration, Mr. Muñoz stated as a public school we offer a preschool education to students that are three and four year old, that are residents and domiciled in Passaic. There is a board policy in place when a particular age group throughout the system is the cut off.

Hearing on Violence, Vandalism, and Harassment, Intimidation, or Bullying, for the reporting period from January 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2020.

Welcome everyone to the Hearing on Violence, Vandalism, and Harassment, Intimidation, or Bullying, for the reporting period from January 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2020. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:17-46, “Two times each school year, between September 1 and January 1 and between January 1 and June 30, at a public hearing, the superintendent of schools shall report to the board of education all acts of violence, vandalism, and harassment, intimidation, or bullying which occurred during the previous reporting period.”

In accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:17-46, N.J.S.A. 18A:36-5.1, N.J.S.A. 18A:37-29, and N.J.A.C. 6A:16-5.2, each district board of education shall observe School Violence Awareness Week and a Week of Respect. During School Violence Awareness Week and the Week of Respect, our staff provided age appropriate instruction focusing on preventing harassment, intimidation, or bullying. School based staff also organized activities including, but not limited to, inviting law enforcement officials to join members of the teaching staff in discussions to prevent school violence, and encourage student diversity and tolerance.

For the reporting period from January 1, 2020, through June 30, 2020, there were 89 HIB investigations completed by appropriate school staff. Of those cases investigated, 35 were alleged cases of HIB and, 54 were confirmed cases of HIB and were affirmed by Board Members.

During this period there were 7 incidents based on race and/or color, 1 incidents based on religion, 0 incidents based on ancestry and/or origin, 10 incidents based on sexual orientation, 10 incidents based on gender and/or gender identity or expression, , 4 incidents based on mental, physical, or sensory disability, and 68 incidents based on other targeted bases. Supportive services such as in-school counseling, skill development, behavioral interventions, and other measures were offered to involved students. In addition, there were 5 suspensions.
