Dear Passaic Students, Parents, and Staff:

On Wednesday, April 1, 2020, the Passaic Public Schools was advised that two employees have tested positive for COVID-19. The employees are not assigned to specific schools for the purposes of their duties.

Individuals identified as having close contact with the identified employee(s) on March 20 or March 24, 2020, when school was not in session, will receive direct notification and will be directed to self-quarantine and monitor their health for symptoms. The City of Passaic Division of Health, following the guidance provided by the New Jersey Department of Health defines close contact as being within six feet of the affected person for ten minutes or greater.

In addition, the locations that the employees were identified as visiting will undergo additional sanitation protocols.

The health and safety of our staff and students remains a priority, and we will remain in consistent communication with local health officials.

Thank you to all of the staff who are working on the frontline to provide our community with the critical supplies they need during this challenging time.
