Dear Passaic Students, Parents, and Staff:

On Monday, October 19, 2020, the Passaic Public Schools was advised that two employees tested positive for COVID-19.

Individuals identified as having close contact with the employees on October 6, 2020, will receive the appropriate notification and will be directed to self-quarantine and monitor their health for symptoms. However, there were no district employees identified as having close contact. The City of Passaic Division of Health, following the guidance provided by the New Jersey Department of Health defines close contact as being within six feet of the affected person for ten minutes or greater.

In addition, the locations that the employees were identified as visiting received additional sanitation protocols.

The health and safety of our staff remains a priority, and we will remain in consistent communication with local health officials.
